With the development of the additional learning needs (ALN) transformation programme by the Welsh Government we thought it would be useful for us to provide you with a briefing and update on what and when things will be happening. Ceredigion will continue to comply with the Education Act 1996 and the current SEN Code of Practice for Wales (2004) which will remain statutory until the new ALNET Act becomes statutory in the summer of 2023. In line with the proposed time-table there will be a three year phased transformation period where both systems run side by side and apply to different cohorts of learners between September 2020 and the summer of 2023.
